



PETITION FOR RECLASSIFICATION FROM NONRESIDENT TO RESIDENT STATUS

A student classified as nonresident may request reclassification upon the fulfillment of the California residency requirements for tuition purposes. The burden of proof to clearly demonstrate both physical presence and the intent to establish residency in California lies with the student. Submit supporting documents with this application.

All documents presented must be valid and dated at least one year before the residence determination date set forth by Mission College. The residence determination date is the date preceding the first day of instruction for each semester or session.

GROUP A

- California State Income tax form (W2 forms and check stubs are not acceptable).
- Documentation of purchase of real estate in California as permanent residence.
- Rental or lease agreement in California.
- California Voter Registration.
- California automobile registration.
- Document on California as military home state record (ex. DD214) or Selective Service.
- Professional License in California.
- California Driver's License or Identification card.

GROUP B

- Utility Bills (gas, telephone, water, cable, etc).
- Active bank accounts.
- Documentation on being a member of California jury panel or social organization.
- Official transcripts from California high school, college, or university.
- Letter or Document from any California State agency having approved or received any State service (unemployment, welfare, rehabilitation, etc).
- Documentation on California insurance (car, health, dental, etc).
- Other legal California documents (court orders, traffic violations, etc).
