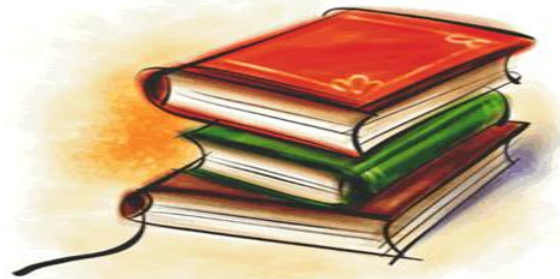
## Priority Registration

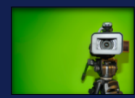
