Program Details

The Math Achievement Pathway to Success (MAPS) offers students an approach to success, particularly for those who have had difficulty in previous math courses. Instructors, counselors and tutors collaborate to help students complete their mathematics requirements.

Students in the MAPS Program attend class for two hours of instruction Monday through Thursday. This instructional time provides class activities and collaborative group work.

In addition to in-class tutoring, the program offers students group tutoring outside of class. Each week, approximately 10 hours of tutoring are offered at various times throughout the day and early evening.

Students who register in the MAPS program will receive books on loan.

MAPS Course Sequence

- Math 903M (Elementary Algebra). Only offered during Fall semester
- Math CM (Intermediate Algebra). Only offered during Spring semester

Who Should Apply?

- Must be an enrolled Mission College student
- Must be eligible for Math 903 in the Fall and Math C in the Spring
- Must be a student who struggles in math

Before Applying Ask Yourself

- Am I committed to extended instruction time for two hours a day Monday through Thursday?
- Am I committed to MAPS for an academic year beginning with Math 903 in Fall and Math C in Spring?
- Am I committed to working hard and learning?
- Am I committed to working in groups and being part of a classroom community?

How to Apply

Completed applications and a copy of your transcript (unofficial will be accepted) and placement test results can be delivered to the Math Faculty Office (S2-402) or MAPS office.
