MAGAZINES AND JOURNALS IN PRINT

The Library subscribes to three fire technology related magazines in print. They are *The California Fire Service*, *Fire Engineering*, and *NFPA Journal*. The current year's issues are located in the periodicals section of the library. Ask for back issues at the Check Out Desk.

Expanded Academic ASAP

Includes magazine, journal and newspaper articles; covers a broad range of topics; many articles available in full-text.

Facts on File World News Digest

News events, people, issues, facts, and figures from 1940 to the present.

OneFile

Full-text articles from the world's leading journals and reference sources. With extensive coverage of the physical sciences, technology, medicine, social sciences, and other subjects.

This is the electronic version of the code. Use the site to search for a Specific Regulatory Section or to do a general keyword search. You can also browse lists of CCR Titles and agencies. There are slight variations from the print version of Barclay's Official California Code of Regulations. For example, Title 8 is listed as Industrial Relations not CAL/OSHA; Title 22 is listed as Social Security not Toxic Substances; and Title 24 is not available.
